Through the generosity of Lake Central School District and Redeemer Lutheran Church in Highland, who have both allowed us to use some of their unused property for garden space, we have been tending **600 heirloom tomato plants!** Remember those tiny heirloom tomato plants we sold at our May geranium sale? They have grown into HUGE plants that should produce about one ton of tomatoes! Some local restaurants have agreed to buy our tomatoes, and we will also have them for sale at the **Sept. 7 Mum Sale**.

On **Saturday, Sept. 14** we will be at Sherwood Golf Course for Beth Sciackitano's **Golf for Autism** event. This year, all proceeds from this event will benefit Planting Possibilities. We are deeply grateful to Beth for her generosity and her dedication to Planting Possibilities' mission. 











